A manuscript is accepted with the understanding that the JIHR has an exclusive license to publish, which means that the manuscript has not been submitted concurrently, accepted for publication, or published in full elsewhere. The JIHR assumes shared copyright with the author(s) of any article published in the JIHR. Reference to the publisher is required before an article published in the JIHR can be copied or reproduced. Requests for reprints of an article as well as requests for permission to reprint an article in another publication should be directed to CAAN.

Terms of the Manuscript Release Agreement

1. Author Re-use of Work

Ownership of copyright remains with the Authors, and provided that, when reproducing the Contribution or extracts from it, the Authors acknowledge first and reference publication in the JIHR, the Authors retain the following nonexclusive rights:

- Oral presentation rights;
- Reproduction rights of the Contribution in whole or in part in any printed volume (book or thesis) of which they are the author(s);
- Reproduction rights of the Contribution in whole or in part in any edited work for which the contributor is the sole editor or senior editor:
- Reproduction rights for the purpose of course teaching by the author and the academic institution where they work at the time;
- Right to post a PDF copy of the Contribution as accepted for publication after peer review on the authors own website or institutional repository *six months after* publication of the printed edition of the Journal, provided that they also give a hyperlink from the contribution to the JIHR host web site http://www.ahacentre.ca
- Rights to reuse figures or tables created by them and contained in the Contribution in other works created by them;
- Rights to photocopy, transmit online, or download to any colleagues for the advancement of scientific research (with the exception of either commercial (for-profit) or systematic third-party sales or dissemination).

Under this agreement the JIHR will not require a request for written permission or fees of any kind for the sharing or reprinting of the contribution as outlined above. However, we do require that the following conditions be met when re-using the material:

- Include a standard copyright line: copyright date, publisher's name, city and province, journal and article title, volume, issue, and page number(s);
- If reprinted electronically, include a link to the JIHR home page http://www.ahacentre.ca
- If reprinted electronically, there must be no charge for viewing the article.

2. License to Publish
